Requirements

- You can only serve on the committee if your student is a freshmen, sophomore or junior (due to conflicts of interest with a senior student)
- You must reapply to volunteer each year

- Vocal Music

Time Commitment

All committee members have access to each application in early April and are responsible for reading all applications for every student who applies. Each application can take approximately 15-20 minutes each to review and includes the following items:

- Application Basic information
- Shorts answers responses
- Resume
- Recommendations Two total, one from a YPAS teacher and one from the community, which can be a school or private teacher.

The committee meets as a group once in late March to review the process.

The committee will also interview each applicant . Interviews will take place on two-three dates in April. Interviews will be held virtually during non-school hours and last approximately 15 minutes each per applicant.
